IX. RESOLUTIONS

1. First Reading

- A. A resolution authorizing a Community Priority Fund - Community Violence Interventions allocation to We The People Opportunity Farm

- Requested use for Community Violence Interventions in the amount of \$180,000
 - We The People Opportunity Farm - \$180,000
- \$170,000 of the originally allocated \$2,000,000 for Community Violence Interventions remains

RECOMMENDATION: Approval

- B. A resolution authorizing a grant from Results for America in the amount of \$25,000 for the period of January 2023 to December 2023

- This \$25,000 grant is part of a larger \$50,000 award to the Washtenaw County community by Results for America, aimed at reducing the impact of fees and fines associated with the justice system.
- \$25,000 is being awarded directly to A Brighter Way.
- Washtenaw County is being awarded \$25,000, which will then be passed through to Supreme Felons, Inc.
 - Private Funds: \$25,000
 - County Match: \$0

2. Final Reading - From January 18, 2023

- A. A resolution to ratify the submission of a grant application to the Department of the Environment, Great Lakes and Energy to support the removal of Tyler Dam and Beyer Dam

- This grant provides resources to help fund the preparation to remove Tyler Dam and Beyer Dam: designing, permitting, going through the bidding process, final estimations for the total cost of the project, and early stages of construction.
- Project budget would total \$670,914 over the period of two and one-quarter years (7/1/23-9/30/25)
 - Federal Funds: \$502,358
 - County Match: \$168,556
 - \$38,556 in-kind
 - \$130,000 drainage district funds

- B. A resolution to accept a grant award from Huntington bank in the amount of \$40,000 to expand eligibility for participants in the Economic Stabilization

Program for COVID impacted Microenterprises for the period of January 1, 2023 to June 30, 2023

- A grant from Huntington Bank for the Office of Community and Economic Development
 - To provide economic support to 5 vendors within the count
 - To provide technical assistance outside of the current Urban County jurisdictions where current pilot program is being served
 - To stabilize and grow microenterprises impacted by the pandemic
 - For the period of January 1, 2023 to June 30, 2023
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- For a total program amount of: \$40,000
 - Local revenue: \$40,000
 - County Match: \$0

RECOMMENDATION: Approval

C. A resolution establishing a Washtenaw County Advisory Council on Reparations

- Creating an Advisory Council on Reparations as a subcommittee of the Board of Commissioners
- The purpose of the council would be to advise the Board and Public on the development of a Washtenaw Reparations Plan
- Recommendations for appointment to the Council would be developed by the Racial Equity Office, recommended to the Chair of the Board of Commissioners, and considered by the Board of Commissioners

3. Single Reading

A. A resolution authorizing the signature of the County Administrator on the contract between the State of Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs and Washtenaw County Health Department on the Michigan Marijuana Operation and Oversight Project in the grant budget amount of \$139,422 for the period of January 1, 2023, through September 15, 2023; amending the budget; and authorizing the Administrator to sign delegate contracts

- Authorizes the acceptance of a grant from the State of Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs to provide education, communication, and outreach regarding the Michigan Medical Marijuana Act and the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marijuana Act
- The grant award is \$139,422 for the period of January 1, 2023 through September 15, 2023
- No County match is required

- C. A Resolution Authorizing the County Administrator to sign the 2021 Homeland Security Grant Program Interlocal Fiduciary Agreement with Macomb County for the period of September 1, 2021, Through May 31, 2024; In the Amount of \$328,055 to Reimburse Washtenaw County for the Approved Homeland Security Planning, Training and Equipment, and Personnel Expenses; and Authorizing the Administrator to Sign Delegate Contracts

- A grant from the US Department of Homeland Security for Washtenaw County's Emergency Management and Homeland Security Programs
 - In agreement with the Southeast Michigan Urban Area Security Initiative
 - Providing funding for local enhancement projects reviewed and recommended by Washtenaw County's Homeland Security Task Force
 - Previous Homeland Security Grant amount for the period of September 1, 2020- May 31, 2023: \$340,914
 - For the period of September 1, 2021 to May 31, 2024
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- For a total amount of \$328,055
 - Federal revenue: \$328,055
 - County Match: \$0
