WHEREAS, the Drainage Board (the "Board") for the various Chapter 20 drain drainage districts (the "District") has designated the area to be served by designated Chapter 20 drains (the "Project") and has issued its Final Orders of Determination; and

WHEREAS, the Board understands that rodents in storm systems can produce fecal (E. coli) and salmonella contamination, as well as depositing debris into enclosed systems; and,

WHEREAS, the Board understands that rodent contamination in stormwater systems poses a potential health and safety hazards for property owners and maintenance staff; and,

WHEREAS, the Water Resources Commissioner has been in discussion with Ypsilanti Township, where all the work is to be performed; and,

WHEREAS, Ypsilanti Township is presenting a resolution to its township board for pest control in the amount of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000.00), and;

WHEREAS, forty-four percent (44%) of the cost of prior services was reimbursed by Ypsilanti Township for service on non-county drain infrastructure, and the township desires to continue the pest control project with costs of non-county drains to be billed to the township.
