The Meeting was called to order by Roger Rayle at 10:05 AM.

The February Minutes were approved.

Jack Eaton moderated the Meeting.

EPA Update-

Josh Moser, with EGLE, mentioned that they have heard there will be a delay in the spring NPL listings and we should know more in the fall. EGLE will keep us posted as they hear from EPA.

EGLE Update-

Chris Svoboda informed us that the Marshy area feasibility study has been reviewed and will be getting a letter out to Gelman and they included CARD's comments and appreciate our input. He will let us know what the outcome is. Then EGLE will work on the Western Area GSI and other areas. Roger asked about the 2017 (CJ) Marshy area data and when that will be in the database?

EGLE is also working on the database updates with the 2023 and 2024 residential data included.

This summer there are GSI sampling tests planned for down gradient and shallow water in the Eastern area studies. They will be doing investigations on the movement in the PZ and wet basements.

Washtenaw Co Update-

Karissa Renberg gave the staff update on the County Health Dept website changes and if anyone wants to give any input on the CARD site, to let them know. Beth thanked Angela Parsons for attaching the Minutes and Agendas and she will be updating it for CARD.

She discussed the upcoming summer homeowner well testing and which homes will be sampled.

Ann Arbor Township Update-

There were no updates

Scio Township Update-

Kathy Knol mentioned that the PFAS contamination on Dino Drive has no new information and she asked EGLE if they had an update? Our reps do not covers this project and Chris will reach out to the project manager who does handle this and discuss having a community meeting and setting it up with the Board of Supervisors. Erin Donnelly mentioned

there is a meeting on the 14th but this was supposed to be a different community meeting with Dan Wild and “notice it out”.

City of Ann Arbor Update-

Erin Donnelly said there are no updates, but they will be having a meeting with EGLE about the shallow groundwater in the City. She did meet with Rita and Vince about their concerns with wet basements, etc. Roger also said he has some new data overlays for the downgradient plume and actual parcels in the zone of movement. Erin would be happy to meet with him on this.

Executive Board Update-

The Board wondered if we can cancel the April meeting due to Roger being out of town and the lack of updates lately. There were no objections with the members present. The Board will discuss in a separate meeting and decide.

Chair Update-

Roger discussed finally getting the “secret sampling” in the Marshy area and all the sampling from there including the highest levels since 1984: 95,600 ppb in a soil sample and 17,200 ppb in a groundwater sample. We will see what the Feasibility Study results show. Roger discussed some other samples on the Gelman site and original property, while discussing some of the history and some of the problems. We discussed some of the phytoremediation system to decontaminate the ground soils. There will be “wetlands permits” applied for.

Roger discussed finding more “grass roots” neighbors who will get involved and maybe visiting the homes who are in the movement of the plume.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:22 AM.
